



## *Dress Code*

The **JG dress code** creates a respectful, distraction-free environment where everyone can fully participate in worship, outreach, dance, and drama activities. Our days involve a lot of movement, teamwork, and time in close community, so clothing should be modest, comfortable, and appropriate for all activities. Please pack with consideration for yourself and for others.

If you're unsure about an item, use this simple test: **raise your hands straight up, then bend over and touch your toes—if anything shows that shouldn't, do not bring it to JG.**

### Girls Tops

- Strapless, spaghetti strap, and halter tops or dresses are not allowed.
- Tank top straps must be at least two finger widths wide.
- Bras, sports bras, and bralettes must be fully covered at all times and should not be intentionally visible. No one should be able to see your bra.
- Shirts that are low-cut, very thin, or slightly see-through must be worn with a tank top or cami underneath. If this isn't possible, please do not pack the shirt.
- Midriffs should not be exposed. While crop tops and high-waisted pants are popular, the amount of movement during JG makes midriff exposure likely, so crop tops are not permitted.

### Girls Bottoms

- Leggings may be worn for dance and drama practices only when paired with a loose-fitting top that fully covers your backside.
- Shorts must be fingertip length or longer.
- Athletic shorts should not be revealing during movement. Remember that dance and drama involve bending, crouching, and stretching—pack accordingly.

### Boys Tops

- Muscle tanks or cut-out shirts are not allowed.
- Shirts must be worn at all times, except on beach day.
- Be sure to pack a shirt and shorts for sleeping, as sleeping arrangements may vary (host homes, church floors, etc.).

### Boys Bottoms

- Shorts must be fingertip length.
- Underwear should never be visible, either above or below pants or shorts.
- Keep in mind that dance and drama activities involve bending and crouching, and nothing inappropriate should be visible during movement.
